Curriculum Access	Ensure curriculum resources are accessible to all.	Ongoing contact with Visual Impairment support service for advice re: visually impaired pupil. Ensure texts are enlarged so that they are clear. Purchase magnification sheets or other resources to support where necessary Ongoing contact with Hearing Impairment support service to advise on pupil with hearing aid. Staff to advise teacher/TA.	Visually impaired pupil to have complete access to curriculum. Hearing impaired student to have complete access to curriculum	July 2020 Ongoing – annual visits	
Access to Information	School to support parents and others to access information on the website or via Parent Mail.	Office staff to contact parents directly where information is needed that may be inaccessible to support with completing forms etc. for example EAL families and those with specific reading and writing difficulties. Translation and other support services to be used by school where necessary.	Parents and other visitors to have access to all information.	Ongoing
